School Facebook Page

Events 2020

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Music and Musical Instruments

In order to increase activity in the area of music in the school it has been proposed by parents of the school, that we put out a request for donations of new or old/previously loved musical instruments. If you have or know any of your extended family or friends that might have any type of musical instruments that they would like to donate to the school, they would be greatly appreciated.

As you are aware all the kids have started drum sessions in the school over the last few weeks.

In addition, guitar lessons will begin once again in the school for kids in 3^{rd} to 6^{th} class. A charge of \notin 45 (15 lessons x \notin 3) per lesson will be collected at the beginning of the course.

Drama

As you probably already know, all children had drama classes with Maggie before Christmas. The funds raised from the Church Gate collection were used to pay for this.

Spanish lessons

The school is hoping to introduce Spanish in the coming weeks for students in $5^{th} \& 6^{th}$ class initially, with a view to extending the lessons to younger children if possible.

Plans for use of Funds

The Parents Association is currently compiling the wish list of ideas of what to spend the fundraising money on. The list was quite long and varied and final proposals will be passed through the Board of Management along with the list of three proposed fundraisers, over the next few weeks.
